HOW WE RATE HOSPITALS: The data come from the Society of Thoracic Surgeons for hospitals that have agreed to share their information with us. Coronary Artery Bypass Surgery: This rating reflects a hospital's performance in isolated coronary artery bypass graft surgery between July 2016 and June 2017. The rating is a composite of four measures: survival (percentage of patients who leave a hospital and survive at least 30 days after surgery); complications (percentage of patients who avoid the most serious complications, including

needing a second operation, developing a deep chest infection, suffering a stroke or kidney failure, and requiring prolonged ventilation); best surgical technique (percentage of patients who receive at least one graft from an internal mammary artery, located under the breastbone, which improves survival); and the right drugs (percentage of patients who receive beta-blockers before and after surgery to control blood pressure and heart rhythm, aspirin or similar drugs to prevent blood clots, and a drug to lower cholesterol). Aortic Valve

Replacement Surgery: This rating reflects a hospital's performance in surgical aortic valve replacement between July 2014 and June 2017. It doesn't include data for a newer procedure, transcatheter aortic valve replacement. The valve replacement rating is a composite of two measures: survival (percentage of patients who leave a hospital and survive at least 30 days after surgery); and complications (percentage of patients who avoid the most serious complications, which are the same as for bypass).
