

Replacing Used Cars:

A Nationally Representative Multi-Mode Survey

Results

Overview of Methodology

Consumer Reports fielded a nationally-representative survey of 2,178 Americans to explore what Americans do with the vehicles they already own when they purchase or lease new vehicles; the ways in which they dispose of the used vehicles, if they do; and what relates to satisfaction with different aspects of the process of disposing of the used cars. The results are based on interviews conducted November 18-26, 2019.

The survey was administered by NORC at the University of Chicago through its AmeriSpeak® Panel to a nationally representative sample. Interviews were administered both online (n = 4,773) and by phone (n = 424). A total of 5,197 Americans completed the initial screener ("In the last two years, have you purchased or leased a vehicle?"). Those who had were asked whether it was a replacement for another vehicle; 2,178 people replaced a vehicle and were eligible for the rest of the survey. Final data are weighted by sex, age, education, and race/ethnicity. All interviews were in English.

TOPLINE RESULTS

The questions presented below were shown to respondents in order. Where appropriate, question verbiage, response answer choices, or direction of scales were randomized or rotated and those instances are noted below.
